Dr Lohokare will use examples and case studies from his experiences from clean technology and advanced materials sectors.

Dr Lohokare is an entrepreneur, angel investor and venture catalyst from the San Francisco Bay area in the US, with investment and board associations on multiple startups. He is currently the MD and CEO of E-Cubed Ventures, a firm with a mission of "Bringing Innovations to Market and Markets to Innovations™". E-Cubed Venture model is to provide a professional platform to form new ventures, execute on commercialization of disruptive technologies/ ideas and incubate world-class companies.

Dr Lohokare has been a leader of industry roadmaps and consortia including co-chair of International Technology Roadmap for Semiconductors. He is also a Member at TiE Angels and Advisor & Chair at VC TaskForce in the Bay area, and venture capital panelist on US National Science Foundation's advanced materials technology commercialization grants allocation.

Previously, Dr Lohokare has been Principal Partner & EVP at 21Ventures, CEO and Board Observer at NanoSilicon Solar and Director at KLA-Tencor and Lam Research, heading New Products and Business Groups.

Dr Lohokare has 9 US/ global patents with more pending. He holds degrees from the Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay and University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. He has also completed an Executive Management program at Stanford University Graduate School of Business.
